SUPPORT RESTORATION OF NOTRE DAME CATHEDRAL: We all grieved at the terrible fire at Notre Dame Cathedral in Paris. We watched with sadness as fire tore through historic Notre Dame Cathedral in Paris, causing severe damage to the centuries-old structure. The impact of the fire on the faithful of the city and of the world is immense, and the full extent will not be known for some time. Next weekend, April 27th & 28th our parish will take up a collection in support of the restoration. The Shrine has the infrastructure to manage donated funds and has established relationships to provide the appropriate due diligence on the distribution of funds. The Shrine has pledged that all proceeds received will be used solely for the assistance of Notre Dame Cathedral and those affected by this tragedy. PASTOR'S CORNER: On behalf of the Dominican Community here at St. Rose, let me wish you all the blessings of the Easter Season and especially of this holy day of Easter. It is a time for us to be grateful for what God has done for us in Christ Jesus. It is a time for hope in the promises of grace in this present life, of bodily resurrection and eternal life. It is a time for us to rededicate ourselves as followers of Christ and children of God. Pope St. Leo I ('the Great') said it better than I could: "Let God's people then recognize that they are a new creation in Christ, and with all vigilance understand by Whom they have been adopted. Let not the things which have been made new return to their ancient instability; and let not him who has 'put his hand to the plough' forsake his work, but rather attend to that which he sows and not to what he has left behind. Let no one fall back into that from which he has risen, but, even though from bodily weakness he still languishes under certain maladies, let him urgently desire to be healed and raised up. For this is the path of health through imitation of the Resurrection begun in Christ." Christ is risen! He is truly risen! **New Catholics** – for me, one of the greatest joys of Easter is welcoming new members into the Body of Christ, the Church. At this year's Easter Vigil, we are welcoming four people into the Church: Chassity Mattingly, Katie Gilpin, and Mark Missildine will be fully initiated (baptized, confirmed, and First Eucharist); Charles Gilpin will be confirmed and receive the Holy Eucharist for the first time. We praise God for giving them the gift of faith and please welcome them to our parish!
