**PASTOR'S CORNER:** Did Jesus ever go on vacation? In the Gospel of Mark, we read: "He said to them, 'Come away by yourselves to a deserted place and rest a while.' ... So they went off in the boat by themselves to a deserted place." [Mk 6:31] God even commanded His people to make one day in seven, not just a day to worship Him, but a day of rest for ourselves. Rest is not just a luxury. It is a necessity for our physical and spiritual life. We are not disembodied spirits. If we are always physically and emotionally exhausted, our spiritual life will suffer as well. Our word 'vacation' comes from a Latin root word that means 'empty.' We need to make some 'empty' space and time in our lives in order to refresh ourselves. Summer vacations can be a good opportunity to do some of this. But every day we should make some time to go 'to a deserted place

and rest a while.’ Rest a while from the constant pressures of daily life, take some time to keep our lives in the Godly perspective we exist in. I often hear people say they have no time for anything but work, work, work. There is an expression that someone ‘worked himself to an early grave.’ But a constant refusing to imitate the Lord Jesus Himself and rest a while can leave us deadened spiritually as well.
