PASTOR'S CORNER: I wanted to thank everyone who attended the Ordination to the Priesthood of David Wheeler on June 29th and his Mass of Thanksgiving the following Sunday. It was a wonderful event. David and his family are very grateful for all the support the people of St. Rose Parish have given him, especially all those who have been praying for his vocation over the years. David had to leave last Sunday for Guatemala, where he will be intensively studying Spanish, an almost indispensable skill in today's

Church. He will celebrate a Mass of Thanksgiving here at St. Rose on Sunday, September 15th, after he returns from Guatemala, and before he heads back to Rome to complete his studies. We will have more details on that as we near the date. One of the signs of a healthy and holy parish is that men and women on a regular basis seriously consider a vocation to priesthood or the religious life. In the last ten years, St. Rose has been blessed to have two men ordained priests, and one woman enter religious life. When Cardinal Egan of New York City was forced to close a parish there some years ago, the parishioners were up in arms. But Cardinal Egan asked them a simple question - When was the last time this parish produced a vocation to the priesthood? It had been more than forty years! Vocations are *everybody's* responsibility. Encourage your children, grandchildren, nieces and nephews to consider a priestly or religious vocation. Please pray that God may continue to raise up vocations - workers in the Lord's vineyard - from St. Rose Parish.
