PASTOR'S CORNER: 1) **Feast of St. Rose** - Please sign up in the back of church if you are able to attend our special celebration of the Feast of St. Rose, our parish's patron saint, on Friday, August 23rd. We will have Mass at 5:30, followed by a procession to the shrine of St. Rose, and then a festive potluck meal in the Parish Center. (Parish will provide the meat and drinks). Please bring a dish and sign up if you can come. 2) **Head Start** - Beginning in July, the Washington County Head Start program began renting a portion of the first floor of the old St. Rose school building. They will have two rooms where their classes will meet, and use of the kitchen and bathrooms. Some of you may recall that Head Start used our school

building for more than 30 years, up until about ten years ago. This will not interfere with our Religious Education program, which meets in the school, nor with the Turkey Supper, nor with reunions which are scheduled for the school, nor with our Fourth Sunday Hospitality breakfasts. We will have to restrict the use of the school for bereavement suppers to only when absolutely necessary, due to the anticipated numbers of people. The contract is only for ten months; Head Start is building its own facility and needs a place until that is finished. Head Start will be paying the parish \$1,200 a month for each of the ten months they are renting. I think it's a good thing for the school to get use as a school, and it will provide the parish with a small additional revenue stream. Head Start was a good neighbor in the past, and I am sure they will be for the coming ten months.

TURKEY SUPPER/FALL FESTIVAL MEETING: A planning meeting for this year's Turkey Supper and Fall Festival will be held on Tuesday, August 13th at 6:30 p.m. in the school. This year's Turkey Supper will be held on Saturday, October 26th! Many volunteers are needed to help make our annual supper a success.
