PASTOR'S CORNER: 1) **New Catholics** - One of the ways God renews His Church is through the constant flow of people seeking join the Church. Last year more than 100,000 adults entered the Church in the United States through baptism or confirmation. That's the size of a small city. Not nearly what it should be, but perhaps more than most people imagine. The vast majority of those people began their journey to the Church through a personal invitation from a friend or family member. If you know of someone who is not Catholic and seems to be searching for their true spiritual home, or if you know someone who was born Catholic but who has been away from Church for many years (or even decades!), invite them to come to Church with you some Sunday. Or if you are married to a non-Catholic, ask if your spouse might be interested in looking into the Catholic Church as their spiritual home. Or if you or someone you know just

has questions about the Faith, give me a call and we can investigate together where God is leading them. The best way we can thank God for the gift of Faith is for us to do our part to bring others to that same Faith. 2) **Feast of St. Rose** – Please sign up in the back of church if you are able to attend our special celebration of the Feast of St. Rose, our parish’s patron saint, on Friday, August 23rd.
