PASTOR'S CORNER: The Secret Prayers, Part 2 – In this brief series, we are looking at the so-called 'secret' prayers of the Mass – prayers said silently by the priest. The next such prayer is made during the Presentation of the Gifts, also known as the Offertory of the Mass. As the priest (or deacon) prepares the chalice, he pours a little water into the wine, while saying, "By the mystery of this water and wine, may we come to share in the divinity of Christ, who humbled himself to share in our humanity." This action probably had its origins in the need in the ancient world to 'cut' wine with water in order to make it more palatable. But the Christian imagination was quick to see in that action something with spiritual significance. The mixing of water and wine suggested the way in which Jesus Christ possessed both a human nature and a divine nature – was both man and God. The son of God assumed our human nature so that

Jesus' humanity, which he shares with each one of us, might become the vehicle for sharing with us his own divinity, what the Fathers of the Church called a 'holy exchange.' Thus, when we share in the Eucharist, we are partaking of the whole Christ - his Body and Blood, (human) soul and divinity - and not just a part of Him. The 'mystery of this water and wine' is that it will become the Blood of Christ, the means by which we can - indeed, have been commanded by the Lord himself - share in Christ's divine nature, power and grace.
