Established by Saint John Paul II in 1985, the AMS is responsible for providing the full range of pastoral ministries available in other U.S. dioceses to those serving in the United States Armed Services, including those stationed at Fort Knox. It provides pastoral care for more than 1.8 million men, women, and children. The Archdiocese for the Military Services receives no funding from the government or the military, has no parishes for a weekly in-pew collection, and must rely principally on private donations to provide many programs and services. participated. I know I'm biased, but I have heard from various people around the area that they consider the St. Rose Turkey Supper to be the best! If that is truly so, it's not just because of the ingredients of our food, but because everything has been done with love! 2) **CSA Appeal** – As of this Friday, thirty-nine households have pledged over \$5500 of our parish goal of \$11,200.
