PASTOR'S CORNER: The Secret Prayers, Part 4 – In this brief series, we are looking at the so-called 'secret' prayers of the Mass – prayers said silently by the priest. The next one takes place at the end of the Preparation of the Gifts. While the priest washes his hands, he says quietly, "Wash me, O Lord, from my iniquity and cleanse me from my sin." Once again, the action served a practical purpose: after handling the gifts of bread and wine, the offerings, and perhaps incense, the priest's hands might be a little dirty. But the liturgy uses this occasion for the priest to ask not just for a physical cleansing, but a spiritual one as well. This short verse is taken from the 51st Psalm. As we watch the priest wash his hands at Mass, we might also ask

the Lord to cleanse us of our sins, the very thing Jesus' sacrifice on the Cross has done, and which our participation at Mass gives us a share in.
