PASTOR'S CORNER: It's usually around this time of year that I write something about the need for us to rest and relax, or even take a vacation. I have a feeling that with the COVID pandemic still upon us, not as many of us as usual will be able or willing to take a traditional vacation. But that does not change the fact that we still need rest and relaxation. Even Jesus needed a break. In the Gospel of Mark, we read: "Jesus said to them, 'Come away by yourselves to a deserted place and rest a while.' ... So they went off in the boat by themselves to a deserted place." [Mk 6:31] God even commanded His people to make one day in seven, not just a day to worship Him, but a day of rest for themselves. Rest is not just a luxury. It is a necessity for our physical and spiritual life. An old proverb has it that 'A bow long bent loses its spring." We are not disembodied spirits. If we are always physically and emotionally exhausted, our spiritual life will suffer as well. Our word 'vacation' comes from a Latin root word that means 'empty.' We need to make some 'empty' space and time in our lives in order to refresh ourselves. Not being able to go places just means that we will have to be a bit more creative about how we make this empty space and time for ourselves. But every day we should make some time to go 'to a deserted place and rest a while.' Rest a while from the constant pressures of daily life, take some time to keep our lives in the Godly perspective we exist in. I often hear people say they have no time for anything but work, work, work. Employers are guilty of a serious injustice in not allowing their workers sufficient time for home life and rest. But sometimes we create our own difficulties. There is an expression that someone 'worked himself to an early grave.' Refusing to imitate the Lord Jesus Himself and rest a while can leave us deadened spiritually as well. Remember, if you can't find a place of refuge in your home or nearby, our church is open throughout the daylight hours, just waiting for you to 'come away and rest awhile.'
