PASTOR'S CORNER: July Fourth - Ten score and forty-four years ago, when our country's Founding Fathers declared these United States independent of England, they did so based on a bedrock principle: "We hold these truths to be self-evident, that all men are created equal, that they are endowed by their Creator with certain unalienable rights, that among these are life, liberty and the pursuit of happiness." It is a sad testimony to our fallen human natures that even as this principle was laid down, there were millions being unjustly deprived of their liberty under the bondage of slavery, often by those very same Founding Fathers. It would take decades and a bloody civil war before that unalienable right would be established. Thousands are protesting around the country to remind us that even now, those blessings of liberty have yet to be fully realized for Black Americans. But this is not the only injustice to be found in our land. Today, millions of our children are unjustly deprived of their unalienable right to life through the crime of abortion. How long and what will it take to secure this right for the innocent? There are no perfect countries any more than there are perfect people. We always find weeds mixed among the wheat.
