Donations fund the education and support of seminarians, religious novices, and lay catechists; the work of religious communities in education, health care, and social services; communication and transportation needs; disaster and emergency relief when necessary; and the Church's ministry to children.

**PASTOR'S CORNER: Annual Friars' Formation Appeal** - The Province of St. Joseph is in a bit of a crisis. It's not a *bad* crisis, but a crisis all the same. Eight men were ordained to the priesthood this past May. Forty-five men in our House of Studies in Washington. Ten men in the novitiate in Cincinnati. Almost sixty men in some stage of initial formation as Dominican friars! Our Province of Dominicans has been truly blessed with vocations these last few years, and we must be deeply grateful for that. But it does present a problem - feeding, clothing, housing, insuring all these young men has strained our Province's resources. This is where we need your help. Our Province has realized that we need to provide a more solid basis of support for our seminarians; and to provide you with an opportunity to share more deeply in the Dominican Mission. You should have already received a letter from me about the Annual Friar Formation Appeal.
